CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- * Two rounds each day. 15 ends for ladies and 18 ends for mixed and men's events.
- * Morning tea 8.45am. Roll up 9.15 am. One roll up only before each round
- * Dead ends. If jack goes out of bounds it is to be replaced as close as possible to the 2m mark.
- * AM winners V AM winners for PM game. AM losers V AM losers for PM game.
- * Tie. Should any game end in a tie, an extra end is to be played to determine a winner. The extra score not to be included on card.
- * Inclement Weather during play-- if game is stopped, COMMITTEE reserves the right to determine on which end the game shall be deemed complete.
- * Points shall be allocated as follows: One (1) point for each winning end, three (3) points for each winning round.
- * The Winners--- will be the team with the most wins & the highest number of points. In the event of an equal number of points, the team with the highest aggregate margin will be the winner. If points and margins are equal the team with the highest total aggregate will be the winner.
- * The Organising Committee shall be the controlling body for the carnival, and subject to the duties of the umpire, their decision will be final in the event of any dispute.
- * Lunch will be served at approximately 12.15 each day.
